# FOR ALL CAMPS

- Participants should come dressed in athletic shorts, T-shirt, and sneakers; however, come prepared for all types of weather.
- **Field trip costs are included in registration fee.**

### Notes for Preschool:

# REGISTRATION

Registration is on a first come, first served basis

Limited space in each program

Participant form/waiver required

At least one half of the registration fee is due at the time of registration. Ask staff for the remainder date since it varies per program. If ½ of balance is not paid at registration, you will not be able to register your child.

Payment Plans are available but all balances must be paid prior to the program start date. If registration fee is not paid in full, your child **will not** be able to **attend** program until balance is paid.

Adjusted fees are available for qualifying families (*excluding Teen Trips.*) Proof of approval for one of the following programs is required: free/reduced lunch program, LEAP, TNIF, SSI/SSDI, WIC OR proof of income for 2015/2016.

### AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)
